

## Planned Study Breaks for Pastors

The John Owen Centre (JOC) at London Theological Seminary (LTS) invites applicants for Planned Study Breaks for Pastors starting in September 2012.

### Content

A Planned Study Break involves:

- Residence at LTS for any one of the three terms.
- Modules from the first, second, or third year of the LTS course, as appropriate, usually focusing on biblical studies.
- A personal study programme under the direction of Dr Garry Williams, focusing on one area of doctrine (e.g. the doctrine of Scripture, the doctrines of grace, or the doctrine of the atonement).
- For those involved in providing theological education, work on the design or revision of a training curriculum with Dr Williams.
- Participation in other JOC and LTS activities as available, for example JOC Study Days, or a class from the Westminster Theological Seminary ThM course.
- Sharing the life of the Seminary community at meals, services, etc.

### Cost

The cost for all accommodation, meals, and tuition is around £3250 for the term. We have established a bursary fund to contribute significantly to the fee for pastors accepted on a Planned Study Break.

### Visa entry

Applicants from overseas can enter the country under a 'Student Visitor' visa.
