Syncretism is common, with some leaders blending different ideas and beliefs into their Christianity, because they don't know how to apply Bible truths to their lives. Pray that Mozambican Christians will be discipled towards faithfulness and integrity.
- Please pray for the **SASRA** 180th Anniversary events that are taking place in various churches this month and for the Supporters Weekend at Willersley Castle, Derbyshire from 15-17 June.
- Sewing, weaving and candle-making are most often seen as hobbies enjoyed here in the West. But for many women in Asia, these "hobbies" can be a genuine source of income to help feed families. Pray for **Gospel for Asia**-supported vocational training which offers women a sense of dignity, teaching them skills that can lead to financial stability.
- Pray today for **FIEC** National Director John Stevens as he speaks at a weekend away with Moorlands Church, Lancaster.
- Hafan is a holiday for Welsh speaking adults run by the **Evangelical Movement of Wales** (EMW) held at Bala, north Wales from 18-23 June. Pray for Geraint Morse who will be leading this event.
- Pray for those attending the Trust Board Meeting of the Evangelical Fellowship of Congregational Churches (EFCC) tomorrow, for wisdom as they seek to deal with the business before them.
- SOLAS are today leading an apologetics conference for the Salvation Army training college in London. Pray for all attending to be better equipped to speak for the Lord in our secular culture.

Time For Change Ministries ask us to remember those who are in prison for the first time and those who are in for the twentieth time; those who are missing their family and those who have no family or friends outside; those who are looking forward to release and those who know they will soon return to prison after release. Time for Change worker Gillian is attending several courses this month; pray that she will learn well and apply what is learnt to her own ministry.
