- **Grace Baptist Partnership** values prayer for Ryarsh Baptist Church as they consider relocating their primary place of worship and witness to Maidstone, Kent. They will be meeting in Maidstone each week starting tomorrow (2 April) for three months as they prayerfully consider this move. Please join them by praying for wisdom and clarity as they make this important decision.
- Pray that all **ReachAcross** supporters and missionaries will be evangelistic in their lifestyle, especially reaching out to Muslims, building bridges of friendship, boldly sharing the gospel, and being good ambassadors for Christ.
- Please pray for Peterhead Congregational Church's daily Lunchtime Holy Week Services starting today (3 April) and running until Friday (7 April). Pray many will respond to the gospel this Easter as Jesus is presented. Pray for School Assemblies and for Peterhead's Children's Mission in partnership with other churches in the town. Give thanks for shared Lent Bible Studies in the community.
- Please pray for the students at the Reformed Theological College, Belfast (part of the Reformed Presbyterian Church in Ireland), as they sit their final exams for this year this week (4 to 13 April), and then go to congregational placements during May and June.

- Give thanks for answered prayer over the recruitment of **Daylight Christian Prison Trust's** next Chief Executive Officer. Gaius Phillingham will be joining Daylight from Easter, please pray for him, his wife Tracey, and their family as he takes up this role, and for the rest of the Daylight team as they help and support Gaius in his new post.
- Christ is risen! Join us as today we celebrate with Christians all over the world and rejoice that Jesus Christ has risen from the grave, defeated death and made a way for us to be rescued from our sins, 'For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.' (1 Cor 15:21-22) He is risen, indeed!

- Please pray for the **Evangelical Movement of Wales** Easter camp that will be held this week (10-14 April). Pray for the leaders, Paul Daniel and Sharon Owen, and Pete Campbell, who will be the chaplain. Pray that the Lord will be at work in the lives of all the young people who will attend and that we will see lives transformed and saved.
- Cornerstone UK are awaiting the result of a recent Ofsted inspection of their Fostering Service, please pray the Lord works in Ofsted's inspection and legal teams to give them a just, positive result. This is also key to the conclusion of Ofsted's legal proceedings against Cornerstone. Praise God for a 'good' rating in the recent Ofsted inspection of their Post-Adoption Support Service. Please pray that the Lord fills current/forthcoming vacancies with the right people and talent that enables Cornerstone to build for the future.
- Please pray for the many people Caring For Life support, specifically; one man sleeping in his car and needing a hostel place; a lady who moved into a new home last month that she'll settle well, keep safe and not let people take advantage of her or her home. Pray for a young man who is very poorly with his mental health and desperate for a move. Praise the Lord for many blessings; new hearing aids for a young lady; bible studies well attended; grants approved for several household items; benefits awarded; flats tidied and cleaned and birthdays celebrated!
- Pray for Access Insurance's local church clients across the UK who were involved in organising Easter activities, services and outreach. Pray these churches will see gospel fruit from their labours.
- Please pray for a new IPC church, Ebenezer Chapel, Luton, starting this Easter, led by Garry Williams. Pray for Gethin Jones who has just moved from Paris to Lille to start a new IPC church, Eglise de la Trinite. There are a number of people from unbelieving backgrounds who are seeking baptism at All Nations Church, Ilford in London. Please pray for those at the church who seek to disciple them.
- Sharing Christ Internationally asks for prayer for the preparation of a Bible presentation by the Bible Society of Mongolia for an event in Ulaanbaatar in May which lasts three days and is predicted to be attended by around 180,000 Mongolians.
- Christian Schools Trust primarily seeks to support and encourage existing independent Christian schools, to lay and maintain a foundation of biblical truth in education, flourish and become established within the educational provision in the UK to the glory of God. Please pray that God would provide the much-needed funds to continue this important ministry.
- The tragic death of Ruth Perry is unspeakably sad. It serves as a reminder that school leaders are human, and the pressures they bear are immense. Please pray for the **Association of Christian Teachers** as they encourage churches to support teachers who take on these enormous responsibilities and provide a safe place for Christian teachers to connect and encourage each other with the gospel. Please also pray for parents and children of Christian families as they work through the implications of School Place Allocations for Primary (happening today 17 April) in England
- London City Mission missionary Brandon Thesee says, 'As society increasingly steers away from the moral truths of God's word, the people that are going to suffer the most is the next generation.' - Please pray that God would provide the right people to be appointed as new trustees of Crossteach so that the organisation has the support and skills required to ensure the work of Crossteach has great impact and increasing growth.

Kristie was dismissed from her role as school pastoral assistant after sharing concerns about sex education on Facebook. Her case was heard in the Employment Appeal Tribunal last month and lay panel members had to be recused for perceived bias on extreme sex education. Pray for justice as they await judgment.

- Give thanks to God for those who came to **UFM's** recent 'Called to Serve' event and pray for the attendees as they seek the Lord's leading for future cross-cultural mission. Please also pray that the various summer teams that are planned would, likewise, be helpful to those considering future opportunities to serve.
- The FIEC is gathering with current and past staff, members of the Trust Board, former Presidents, friends, and church leaders in London today (22 April) to celebrate and reflect on FIEC's Centenary year. Please pray that this will be a really encouraging time as they remember God's blessings and look to the future.
- 23 Little Hill Church's international student service is today (23 April). Please pray that a good number of people will attend, that there will be a clear gospel message from Gary Prickett and for many to respond in repentance and faith.
- Please pray that 'Challenges to Living God's Way' a new book from **Lovewise** for young people addressing tough topics on sex and relationships will prove pastorally helpful. Please also pray for a presentation on 'Pornography: Dangers & Decisions' being given at a secondary school in Cheshire this week.
- Pray that the Free Church of Scotland would remain faithful to its biblical and theological roots and continue to be a strong witness for Christ in a world that desperately needs his love and grace.
