## August 2022

- **UFM** are excited to be able to meet in person for their Summer Conference for the first time in three years. Please pray for a wonderful time of sharing and fellowship and for George Hawkins as he takes the main Bible ministry this week (1-5 August) at Swanwick.
- Pray for Gospel for Asia as they have been exhibiting at the New Wine United conference this week. Pray that many people would have attended their stand, learned about the vital work Gospel for Asia does and signed up to support them in prayer and financially.
- Please pray for the Reformed Presbyterian Church of Ireland junior camps happening currently (30 July 6 August). Pray for the leaders' teaching and example, and pray that young lives will be transformed by God's Word.

Pray also for Church Society's AGM on 31 August (at JAEC). Pray for speakers, organisation, and usefulness of the conference for junior evangelicals as they seek to contend for the gospel in the Church of England.
- Please continue to pray for staff recruitment in Cornerstone Adoption and Fostering Services' business support and social work teams as well as for new Panel Members in the Tees Valley region and new Trustees to strengthen our dedicated Board. Cornerstone are particularly in need of a new Administrator and Social Worker for their Doncaster team, based at our Head Office near Doncaster airport but covering the whole region.

- Please pray for Therfield Chapel (part of the **Evangelical Fellowship of Congregational Churches**) where Paul Dutton was inducted as the new pastor last month. Give thanks with us for God's goodness and pray that the ministry will flourish, that the saints will be built up, that sinners will be saved, and that the Lord will have all the glory.
- Give thanks to the Lord for the Free Church of Scotland church plants that are taking place in communities across Scotland. Pray for the vision for 30 new churches by 2030 and the vision for a healthy gospel church for every community in that God will make the paths straight and preparations will run smoothly.
